Executive Summary

A. Preparing for the development of a district Strategic Plan

At a meeting of the Board on September 10, 2018, New Jersey School Boards association made a presentation to the board on the 3D Strategic Planning Services available through the NJSBA. The information supplied to the district included a review of the following information and requirements:

- commitment of time and resources
- school and community level involvement
- strategic planning to meet the needs of the district
- potential participants to be included in the process

The South Harrison Board of Education subsequently contracted with the New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA) to provide services to assist and facilitate a Strategic Planning process to commence early in 2019.

B. 3D Strategic Planning Meetings

On January 10, January 26 and February 25, 2019, Terri Lewis and Jesse Adams Jr., Field Service Representative for NJSBA, facilitated three Strategic Planning Meetings with administration, district personnel, parents, community members and board members in attendance. Outcomes of these meetings include:

- 1. January 10, 2019: Strengths and Challenges
- 2. January 26, 2019: Vision of the Future
- 3. February 25, 2019: Goals and Objectives

C. Extension of the Plan

Due to pandemic coupled with extenuating circumstances at the district level that prevented implementation of much of the plan, the board voted to extend the plan forward to 2025 at the January 3, 2023 meeting of the board.
