Physical examinations are an important part of healthy growth and development. It is recommended by the New Jersey Department of Health that your child receive a physical exam at least once during each of his/her developmental stages:

- **Early childhood (pre-school through grade 3)**
- **Pre-adolescence (grades 4 through 6)**
- **Adolescence (grades 7-12)**

New Jersey State Law requires that all physical examinations be done at the student's "medical home" (family physician's office).
