

Read Across America Week - (March 2 - March 6)

Monday, March 2nd: Dr. Seuss' birthday - Read Across America Day

- Celebrate Dr. Seuss' book ***Green Eggs and Ham*** by wearing **green**.
- Students in grades 4-6 begin bringing age and content appropriate, **gently used** books to swap in our Swap and Shop "bring a book, get a book" event which will take place on Friday, March 6th. Books will be swapped within grade levels. Participation in this book swap is optional for grade levels.

Tuesday, March 3rd:

- Celebrate Dr. Seuss' book ***I'm Not Going to Get Up Today*** by cozying up with a good book while wearing **PJ's and bringing a stuffed animal** to school.
- Students in grades 4-6 may continue to bring in an age and content appropriate, gently used book for the Swap and Shop "Bring a Book, Get a Book" swap.

Wednesday, March 4th:

- Celebrate Dr. Seuss' book ***Wacky Wednesday*** with **wacky wear** (e.g hats, hair, clothes).
- Students in grades 4-6 may continue to bring in an age and content appropriate, gently used book for the Swap and Shop "Bring a Book, Get a Book" swap.

Thursday, March 5th:

- Celebrate Dr. Seuss' book, ***Oh, the Places You'll Go!*** by wearing **college/university shirts/colors** OR **dressing to the career** students hope to pursue.
- Students in grades 4-6 may continue to bring in an age and content appropriate, gently used book for the Swap and Shop "Bring a Book, Get a Book" swap.

Friday, March 6th:

- Celebrate Dr. Seuss' book ***Cat in the Hat*** by wearing red, white, and black.
- Grades 4-6 students will participate in the Swap & Shop "Bring a Book, Get a Book" event.
- At the end of the day all students will move to the hallways in a final "drop everything and read" event. An announcement will be made at 2:45pm for DEAR to begin and at 3:00pm students should return to their classrooms.
