Dear South Harrison Families,

This summer, all students currently enrolled in Grades K through 5 are invited to participate in our Virtual Summer School. The focus of Summer School is to help your child maintain the progress that has been made in the areas of Reading and Mathematics. We will be using the educational program, iReady, for our Virtual Summer Program. iReady is connected to the New Jersey Student Learning Standards and the instructional activities within our classrooms.

Virtual Summer School is from **July 11th-August 11th** and does not require your child to come to school. Instead, your child will go to the South Harrison Township School District website and sign in to the iReady platform. The students will be expected to complete assignments on this program for approximately 60-90 minutes per week (30-45 minutes for Mathematics and 30-45 minutes for ELA--not to exceed 90 minutes per week). Our Virtual Summer School teacher(s) will be able to chart your child's progress and share a weekly progress report with you via email. If your child meets the requirements set forth by the Virtual Summer School teacher, there will be a special gift given to him/her upon return to school in September. Students who sign up will also receive information at an assembly prior to the end of the year.
