As summer is rapidly ending, it is time to start preparing for school! I would like to take the time to welcome you and your child(ren) to the 2020-21 school year. To ensure a smooth transition back to school, we have gathered some important information to send in this “Welcome Back to School” email. As an important reminder, LUNCHES WILL NOT BE SERVED. Instead, students will have a designated snack time and either bring their own snacks, or they can purchase a small snack (\$0.75) or small bottle of water (\$0.75). Your child’s teacher will share more information regarding this process.

Virtual “Meet the Teacher”: For those students enrolled in the All Virtual Program or Cohort B in Grades 4-6, classroom teacher(s) will send a video to families on Thursday, September 3. Teachers will introduce themselves, share the daily schedule, and provide a quick video tutorial on how to log onto Google Classroom where instruction will be organized during virtual learning. All virtual students will have a scheduled time to meet with their teacher(s) during the month of September to ensure a smooth transition and this will be reevaluated for October. **Your child’s schedule will reflect this shortly.**


To assist in a safe and organized first week of school, the following information is very important. If you are driving your child to school, your child should arrive no earlier than 8:20 AM (no supervision is available prior to this time). If your child requires before or afterschool supervision, please contact the YMCA Program office directly at (856) 845-0720 for registration details. If you will be picking up your child every day or on recurring days, please complete the **Parent Pick-Up Form**. For changes in your

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child's normal dismissal routine, please complete the *Change in Daily Pick-up Procedure Notice*, or send a note to your child's teacher. Be on the look-out for another email detailing our new parent pick-up procedure.

Make sure you visit our website for school supply lists. We are suggesting the same supplies for virtual and in-person, and students at home should stock up on plenty of paper.
