As required by law, every school district employee is required to have a Mantoux (Tuberculosis) test prior to employment. If you wish, you may have this test performed by your personal physician.

However, if you are a resident of Gloucester County, the Gloucester County Health Department will perform this test at no charge on the second and fourth Monday of each month, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. If you elect to have the test done at the Health Department, please ask them for a verification form indicating that your test was completed. When you receive this verification form, please return it to the Superintendent's office.

Please contact the Health Department prior to your testing in case an appointment must be made, or the day of the testing has been changed.
